How to obtain an ETA for Canada

All passengers travelling to Canada are required to complete an online form used to screen passengers under the Visa Waiver Program. This is called ETA - Electronic Travel Authorisation.

The Visa Waiver Program enables citizens of participating countries to travel to Canada for tourism, business or transit purposes for 6 months from the day they enter Canada without obtaining a Canadian visa.

Passengers may apply for authorization via ETA at any time prior travelling to Canada but are encouraged to do so at least 72 hours before travelling. A fee of \$7 Canadian dollars applies. All passengers are required to present a printed copy of the authorisation to Customs and Border Protection.
